Dear Parent/Carer

I am delighted to welcome you to the new academic year at Lathom. Our new Year 7 students have settled extremely well and, with the support of our older students, have made an excellent start to life at Lathom. The standard of student behaviour in lessons and around school has been superb and students have returned to school well organised and with the correct equipment. Many thanks for your support in making sure that uniform standards are high and our students look smart and represent the school very well in the community. I would ask that any outstanding uniform issues are resolved this weekend to ensure that all students reach the standards that we can be proud of.

Students have been made aware of some minor changes to the school's Behaviour System to ensure consistent behaviour that we can all be proud of. In line with our zero tolerance policy, we maintain an absolute commitment to same day sanctions in all cases where behaviour falls short of the Proud@Lathom expectations. These sanctions are non-negotiable in all cases as we are determined that each and every student is able to be the very best they can be. The school's sanctions now include detentions of 30 minutes for failure to comply with expectations, 1 hour for behaviour that is disrespectful or negatively impacts on learning and 1 hour 30 minutes in cases of serious concern or where a previous sanction has been refused. Both positive and negative behaviours are now linked to a points system, operating alongside our attendance initiatives. We will be sending you news of our exciting attendance initiatives next week.

Over the coming weeks, we will be taking every opportunity to develop student involvement in leadership. Our Year 10 trained Peer Listeners will meet with every student in Year 7 to help them complete the Lathom Bronze Passport. We are very proud of the success of our Peer Listeners and I am delighted that this year the students will be working towards official recognition for their hard work and skills by completing the Student Leadership Accreditation. Our new senior prefect team takes a lead role in ensuring that the Lathom student experience is always positive and all students are involved in wider school life and the community.
