**Year 11 Parents Evening Thursday 9 February 2017**

We are pleased to invite you to the Year 11 Parents' Evening to be held on Thursday 9 February 2017 from 4.00pm to 7.00pm.

During this evening you will receive your son/daughter's **full report** and their **trial exam results**. You will have the opportunity to talk to your son/daughter's subject teachers and Form Tutor about progress and any areas where they can be helped to improve.

Staff from the House team, a Young Peoples Service Adviser, local colleges and training providers will also be available in the Arts Theatre throughout the evening to discuss what the trial exam results could mean for your son or daughter and what they can do to secure their future plans.

As exam time can be a really stressful time for everyone involved, the evening will also include a GCSE support session for parents. The presentation will give practical advice on how you can support your child during the exam period, both in respect of revision and exam preparation and in managing their stress. The presentation will run at 4.45pm and again at 5.45pm, both in the school library.

We cannot stress how important this evening is for both you and your son/daughter. We need to work together to give them the best possible chance to secure successful outcomes this summer. Because it is vital that this happens, **attendance to this evening is one of the 'Prom Passport'** criteria that must be met for your son/daughter to attend the end of year Prom. If you are genuinely unable to attend the event with your son/daughter, please get in touch with school and we will make alternative arrangements to meet you so that the criteria can be met.

To ensure that the evening runs as smoothly as possible we are asking students to arrange appointment times with staff and a sheet is attached for this. To minimise your waiting time to see subject teachers we would ask that appointment times are limited to five minutes. If you feel that you need more time please feel free to arrange a further appointment for more detailed discussion.

We look forward to seeing you at this extremely important event in the preparation for the GCSE examinations.
